- 10,816 children’s winter coats, hats & gloves distributed at over 103 local schools and nonprofit agencies.

INCOME TAX PREPARATION—VITA PROGRAM

- 2,143 Income tax returns prepared in Allen County /Over \$2.4 million in tax refunds to local low to moderate income families in our community.

SECOND CHANCE LEGAL INITIATIVE

- 156 low to moderate income Individuals assisted with Expungement of criminal records, a major barrier to better housing, employment and education.

ICAN VOLUNTEER TEAM

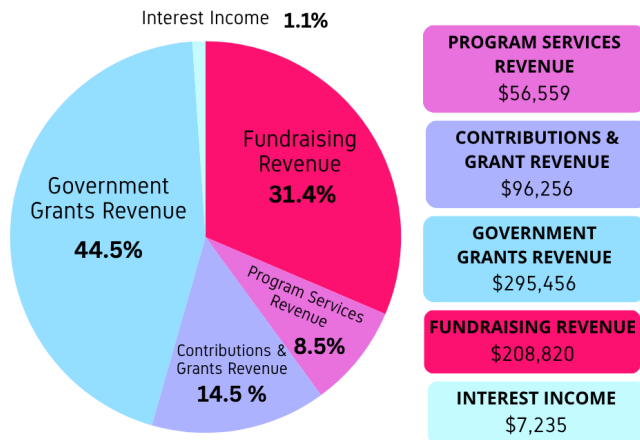
- 110 volunteer projects completed, filling 637 volunteer shifts and engaging 357 individuals with developmental disabilities in meaningful service.

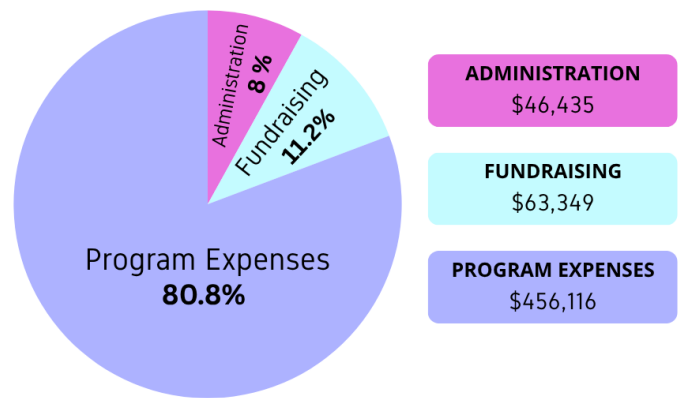
